
Before you begin installing this seat, please read all installation instructions and warnings thoroughly.

This seat is designed to be used on the model vehicles described above. Use of this seat on any other vehicle or failure to install this seat properly may result in an improperly mounted seat and could result in unexpected movement of the seat and loss of control of the vehicle, thereby placing the occupants of the vehicle and others in a potentially dangerous situation.


This seat system is intended to be used with seat belts at all times. Do not rely on the seat to maintain the seating position of occupants, in the event of an accident.

### WEAR SEAT BELTS AT ALL TIMES

Read and follow, precisely, all installation instructions provided when installing this product. Failure to do so may result in a poor fit and could place occupants of the vehicle in a potentially dangerous situation.


## Adjuster Knob Installation

### Step One

The Adjuster Knob will be installed on the outboard side of the seat which will be determined by whether the seat will be installed on the driver's side or the passenger side of the vehicle.


Locate the rod protruding from the bottom of the seat back. Slip the hole in the bottom of the Adjuster Hub over the end of the rod. Place the Step Washer over the end of the rod (inside the hub) with the convex side out. Then slide the Flat Washer over the M6x10 Bolt and thread the bolt into the opening in the rod.

Holding the hub with one hand, use the 10 MM Hex Socket to tighten the bolt.



### Step Two

Align the snap on fingers of the Adjuster Knob with the larger notches with the steps on the Adjuster Hub and press the knob onto the hub until it snaps into place.



## Seat Installation



### WARNING

The seat is designed to be installed on the original seat riser. DO NOT remove or loosen any of the original seat riser anchor bolts. Doing so may cause improper anchoring of the seat, which could result in serious injury, to you and others.



### Caution

Note: Before beginning the seat installation, set the parking brake, place the vehicle in gear or park and chock the wheels to reduce the risk of the vehicle unexpectedly moving, which could result in serious injury.


### Step One

#### Remove the existing seat from the vehicle.

Remove the four (4) nuts that mount the seat track slides to the riser. Do not throw away the four (4) nuts since they will be reused.

The nuts are under the ledge on the riser.

Then remove the bucket seat and track slides from the vehicle (the seat riser will remain in the vehicle).






## WARNING

DO NOT reuse the original mounting bolts. Reuse of the bolts could cause the seat to loosen, which could result in loss of control of the vehicle, causing bodily injury to the vehicle occupants and to others.

### Step Two

#### Remove the tracks.

Lay the seat down with the bottom side facing up. Push down on the track bar to slide the track forward, allowing access to the rear track mounting bolts. Remove the bolts and discard them.





### Step Three

#### Remove the tracks.

Push down on the track bar again to slide the track toward the rear of the seat. Remove the front track mounting bolts and discard them.

Do not throw away the tracks, they will be mounted to the Bestop seat.







**WARNING**

Use only the bolts provided in the Parts Kit when installing the new seat. Failure to do so may cause the seat to loosen, resulting in loss of control of the vehicle and causing serious bodily injury to the vehicle occupants and to others.

### Step Four

#### Install the tracks on the Bestop Seat.

Lay the Bestop seat down with the bottom of the seat facing up. Select the hole pattern on the seat that applies to your vehicle.

While the track slides are to the rear of the seat, place the tracks onto the Bestop seat. Install two of the M8-1.25x25 Bolts from the Parts Kit in the front track mounting holes. Finger tighten the bolts.

### Step Five

#### Install the tracks on the Bestop Seat.

Press down on the track bar and slide the tracks forward. Install two of the M8-1.25x25 Bolts from the Parts Kit in the rear track mounting holes. Tighten the rear bolts to 21 ft/lbs, using a #30 Torque Wrench.


## WARNING

Failure to tighten the bolts and nuts to the specified torque can result in the seat loosening, thereby causing serious bodily injury to the vehicle occupants and to others.

### Step Six

#### Tighten the Front Bolts.

Press down on the track bar and slide the tracks toward the rear of the seat. Tighten the front bolts to 21 ft/lbs, using a #30 Torque Wrench.




## WARNING

Disconnect the leads (positive and negative) from the battery before beginning the Thermal Seat Installation.

### Step Seven

#### Install the Control Switch Plate

Orient the Control Switch Plate on the outside of the seat riser near the center. Mark the location of the holes in the plate. Drill a 1/8" hole at each mark. Install the plate using a 1/4" Self-Tapping Screw from the Small Parts Kit in each location.




## WARNING

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### Step Eight

#### Install the Switch Assembly

Orient the Switch Assembly with the seat image on the switch upright and feed the wire leads through the hole in the Control Switch Plate. Push the switch into the hole until the spring clip catches securing the Switch Assembly to the Control Switch Plate.






## WARNING

Disconnect the leads (positive and negative) from the battery before beginning the Thermal Seat Installation.

### Step Nine

#### Connect Seat Wires to Switch Assembly

Locate the wire connectors from the cushion and the back of the seat. Connect them to the two connectors in the Switch Assembly that have three prong connectors.




## WARNING

Disconnect the leads (positive and negative) from the battery before beginning the Thermal Seat Installation.

### Step Ten

#### Connect the Power Supply Leads

Attach the connector on the Power Supply Leads (with the Black and Red Wires) to the remaining connector (two prong connector) on the Switch Assembly.




## WARNING

Failure to tighten the bolts and nuts to the specified torque can result in the seat loosening, thereby causing serious bodily injury to the vehicle occupants and to others.

### Step Eleven

#### Install the Seat in the Vehicle.

Place the seat in the vehicle. Align the studs on the tracks with the holes in the seat riser. Reinstall the four (4) nuts that were removed in Step One on the track studs. Tighten the nuts to 21 ft/lbs, using a #30 Torque Wrench.


### Step Fourteen

#### Connect Power Supply

Run the red power supply wire under the carpet to the outside of the seat and forward along the edge of the doorjamb to the fuse panel. Cut the red lead to the required length and strip the insulation. Use the Butt Connector in the Small Parts Kit to connect the red lead and the wire on the Fuse Holder. Use a crimping tool to crimp the Butt Connector and connect the two wires.

Use the Wire Ties in the Small Parts Kit to secure the wires where necessary.

Replace the glove compartment and reconnect the battery cables.

Disconnect the leads (positive and negative) from the battery before beginning the Thermal Seat Installation.

### Step Fifteen

#### Installing Two Seats

If you are installing two seats, you will only need to use one Fuse Holder. Route the red lead from the driver's side under the seat, under the carpeting around the console and along the same path as the passenger seat lead. Connect it into the same Butt Connector with the wire on the Fuse Holder.


The ground lead will connect to the rear outside bolt on the driver's side seat.



## Caution

Tilting the seat back to near horizontal could cause interference to the rear wheel house and may cause damage to the back of the seat.

## WARNING

Never adjust the driver's seat or seat back when the vehicle is moving. You could lose control of the vehicle and injure someone.

This seat system is intended to be used with seat belts at all times. Do not rely on the seat to maintain the seating position of occupants, in the event of an accident.

Always drive and ride with your seat back upright and the lap belt snug across the hips to reduce the risk of serious injury to the abdomen or neck that could be caused by sliding under the seat belts in a collision.

Children should always ride with the seat back in the fully upright position. When the seat back is not fully upright, there is a greater risk that the child will slide under the safety belt and be seriously injured in a collision.

**NOTE:** For proper use of child seats in this vehicle, refer to the instructions provided with the child seat and to the vehicle owners manual.

### ***Care of your Bestop Seat***

Your seat is made of the finest materials available. To keep it looking new and for the maximum possible wear, it will need periodic cleaning.

**Washing:** The seat fabric should be washed often using a mild detergent, warm water and a soft bristle brush. Rinse with clear water to remove all traces of soap.
